

Southwestern Electric Cooperative, Inc. Minutes of the Regular Meeting July 24, 2025 Greenville, IL

The regular meeting of the Board of Directors of Southwestern Electric Cooperative, Inc. was held on Thursday, July 24, 2025, at 6:30 p.m. at the office of Southwestern Electric Cooperative headquarters in Greenville, IL pursuant to notice given. President Jerry Gaffner called the meeting to order and led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Introduction of New VP of Operations:

Buehler introduced Cannon to the board. His first day was June 2. He gave a brief overview of his professional and personal life. The board welcomed him to SWECI. Cannon left the meeting at 6:37 p.m.

Executive Session:

At 6:38 p.m., Jennings made a motion to enter into executive session to discuss strategic plan, personnel, member, and legal matters. Warner seconded; motion carried. Stine joined the meeting via conference call at 6:39 p.m. and left the meeting at 7:22 p.m. At 8:09 p.m., Hartlieb made a motion to leave executive session. Jennings seconded; motion carried.

AIEC Board Meeting Report:

There was no AIEC board meeting for July. Schwarm gave an update on AIEC's Annual Meeting preparations and financial report.

Director Training Report:

Schwarm gave verbal and written reports for the CFC Forum. Some of the topics discussed were safety, generation, investing, geopolitical risks, cyber security, and leadership. Schwarm noted there was a good mix of staff and directors present.
